



# Student Exposure Criteria Decision Tree



**Contact tracing CALL/EMAIL**  
Must have been within 0-6 ft distance of COVID-19 positive person, for greater than 15 cumulative minutes over 24-hour period.

**WITHOUT** Symptoms

**WITH** Symptoms (screening)

- \* **No** testing required
- \* Continue to attend school
- \* Continue to wear a mask indoors

**Get a COVID-19 Test**

**(+) Positive Test**

**(-) Negative Test**

**Self-Monitor**  
\* Continue to monitor for 14 days  
\* Continue to wear a mask indoors

- Notify school of positive Test
- Isolate & stay home until:
- Fever free without medications for 24 hours, **AND**
- Symptoms improve, **AND**
- 10 Days have passed since positive Test

**Stay Home IF YOU HAVE:**

- Fever **AND**
- COVID Symptoms

\* **IF NO FEVER CONTINUE TO ATTEND SCHOOL**

**If symptoms develop**  
(See screening)

**If tested POSITIVE**  
(See screening)

**RETURN TO SCHOOL**

**COVID-19 Symptoms Include But Are Not Limited To:**

Fever $\geq$ 100.4 °F or chills	Fatigue	Cough	Headache	Sore throat
New loss of taste or smell	Shortness of breath	Muscle or body aches	Nausea or vomiting	Diarrhea
Congestion or runny nose **	Red or itchy eyes **			

\*\* Students with underlying medical conditions, parents should consult with the student's medical provider to determine if the student is medically safe to be at school. (Ex, can include ability to wear a mask due to diagnosis, asthmatic students who require nebulizer treatments, etc.)
